Virtual NTS Traffic Net Begins March 5, 2025

Many Technician class amateurs miss out on fun and skills learning of traffic handling because they reside in areas of the country where local traffic nets on VHF repeaters don't exist. The Virtual NTS Traffic Net (VNTN) seeks to address this problem with the creation of a Zoom-based local traffic net that can be accessed by anyone with an internet connection.

VNTN will accept check-ins and radiogram traffic utilizing standard phonetics and prosigns; in short, participants will enjoy the same experiences as those who check into conventional "RF" traffic nets. The net will incorporate a "hands-on" training approach in traffic procedures, radiogram creation, and relay.

It is our hope that new amateurs who participate in VNTN will be motivated to join section and region nets on HF after upgrading to a higher license class.

The Net will meet weekly, and hold its inaugural session on Wednesday, March 5, 2025 at 7:00 PM ET. The VNTN URL is: https://bitl.to/3xj4>.





N1MM Setup for Field day

Here are some tips for MARA club members, and others, to use the N1MM logging program for <u>Field Day</u>. Non-club members are free to use this info as well, just ignore the points about specifying MARA as your club. Or if you want to send points our way, feel free!

First, download and install <u>N1MM logger</u> onto your Windows machine. Then select File → "New Database…" and enter w1gz as the file name. Next select the File->"New Log in Database: w1gz.s3db" menu option.






Configure the log for Field Day (FD). Don't worry about specifying your club affiliation at this time. We'll take care of that later when you submit your log to the <u>ARRL</u>. Make sure the "Sent Exchange" is correct for our setup. Also make sure the "Mode" is set to SSB+CW+DIGITAL.

Next setup the hardware and modes by opening the "Config" menu.


Select the "Port" (usually a serial port), "Radio" and "Details" for your radio.




Next, setup the "WSJT/JTDX Setup" tab if you are going to run FT8/FT4

First you must install wsjt-x, I suggest <u>wsjt-x improved</u> using the AL (alternate layout) which is optimized for Laptops and small screens. Then setup the N1MM tab for wsjt.



Next, if you have a network setup for the computers, open the network status window and check for the other computers in the network.




You can open the WSJT application by going to "Window" and selecting "Load WSJT/JTDX" at the bottom.

When you start operating, do an OPON in the call enter box or [CTRL] O to enter your call as the current operator.

Once Field Day has started, log a QSO by selecting the band and mode being used if not connected to the radio, type in the other station's callsign and exchange then press enter when done. Try to use use consistent ARRL section abbreviations.

NOTE: If using WSJT all logging is done by WSJT, do NOT enter anything in the N1MM logging window.



You can start and stop N1MM as many times as you want during the course of the contest.

NOTE: If you are using FT8/FT4 close the WSJT window before closing N1MM.

The grid locator for MT. Wachusetts is **FN42BL**.

Setup WSJT-X

In wsjt-x open File→Settings, Advanced tab check the "Special operating activity" box, then check the "Arrl Field Day" button.
